Chloé Foods Corp., which was 16th on last year's list, is no longer women-owned. It was acquired by EM-ESS Acquisition on May 26, 2009, and is now known as Blue Ridge Farms. New York area includes New York City and Nassau, Suffolk and Westchester counties in New York, and Bergen, Essex, Hudson and Union counties in New Jersey. Crain's New York Business uses staff research, extensive surveys and the most current references available to produce its lists, but given the confidential nature of the information for many privately held women-owned companies, it is not possible to identify and include every company that would qualify for the list. To qualify for this list, a company must be a privately owned business headquartered in the New York area, and 51% or more of the business must be owned by a woman. Travel agencies are excluded.
